HIGHLIGHTS

- Retail prices of most food commodities monitored in 12 markets across Nepal slightly increased in October 2013 due to an increase in demand during the Dashain and Tihar festivals.
- Supply of food and non-food commodities has improved across the country—even in the Hills and Mountains—as a result of increased access to roads and trails.

NATIONAL MARKET DEVELOPMENT

Price

In October 2013, most retail prices of food commodities monitored across the country showed a declining trend as compared to three months earlier (with the exception of red potato and wheat flour) and an upward trend as compared to the same period last year (with the exception of edible oils). Retail prices of food commodities showed an increase monthon-month: coarse rice and wheat flour increased by 1.4 and 0.7 percent respectively; black gram and broken lentil went up by 3.5 and 0.1 percent respectively; and red potato and chicken meat increased by 8.5 and 0.5 percent respectively.

Price trends in regional markets indicated a somewhat different trend than the national average, with an upward trend of the price of coarse rice and wheat flour in the Terai markets and the major consumer markets of Kathmandu and Pokhara, and a declining trend in the Hills and Mountain markets. This is mainly due to resumption of transportation services.

Most wholesale prices regularly monitored by FNCCI/AEC in the five large markets of Birtamod, Kathmandu, Butwal, Surkhet, and Dhangadhi showed an upward trend over the past month. In the Kalimati Fruits and Vegetables Market, the wholesale price of fresh vegetables showed a seasonal fluctuation: prices of pumpkin, cabbage, broad leaf mustard and French bean declined due to increasing production, while that of dry onion, bitter gourd, okra, smooth gourd and carrot went up with the start of the lean season.

As per the latest macroeconomic situation report released by Nepal Rastra Bank in October 2013, the overall consumer price index (CPI) was 196.0, an increase of 0.8 percent month-on-month. The inflation rate, as measured by the year-on-year increase in the CPI, was 8.4 percent. The food and beverage group of the CPI was 236.2, an increase of 0.7 percent month-on-month and 10.0 percent year-on-year; several sub-groups showed high year-on-year increases: meat and fish (18.5 percent), vegetables (14.0 percent), cereal grains (11.5 percent), fruits (9.2 percent) and spices (8.6 percent). The non-food and services group of the CPI was 166.6, an increase of 0.8 percent month-on-month and 6.9 percent year-on-year.

Supply

The supply situation across the country is normal due to the smooth operation of transportation services with the start of the winter season. However, the food supply in the Eastern region, mainly Khotang, Okhaldhunga and Solukhumbu, has not yet resumed fully as a result of the interruption of ferry services in Jayramghat and Ghurmi over the Koshi River. This has partially hampered the supply of food and also increased the cost of transportation and the delivery time.

Outlook


Prices of food commodities are likely to remain stable or decrease as a result of the ongoing harvest of summer crops. Prices of non-food commodities, which had increased during the festival and election periods, are expected to remain stable or decrease due to a decline in demand.

The paddy harvest is expected to be better than last year's. This will increase the availability of a key staple food, thereby contributing to an improvement in the food security situation in Nepal.



Average retail price over 12 month period*


NPR per kilo or liter
