### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- In January 2014, retail prices of most food commodities monitored in 12 markets across Nepal were relatively stable with some marginal fluctuations.
- Overall inflation rate in January 2014 was 9.7 percent. The food and beverage group was higher at 12.9 percent as were several sub-groups: meat and fish (24.5 percent), vegetables (19.0 percent), fruits (14.5 percent) and cereal grains (12.7 percent).

## **NATIONAL MARKET DEVELOPMENT**

#### **Price**

Retail prices of food commodities monitored across the country were relatively stable with some marginal fluctuations in January 2014. On a month-on-month basis, retail prices of coarse rice, wheat flour and broken lentil increased by 1.2, 1.2 and 1.7 percent respectively, while that of black gram, soybean oil and chicken meat declined by 1.0, 1.3 and 3.3 percent respectively. However, the price of red potato sharply declined by 12.3 percent; this is mainly due to the increased supply of recently harvested winter potato crop. Prices, as compared to three months earlier, indicated an upward trend for wheat flour, broken lentil, soybean oil and chicken meat, and a downward trend for coarse rice, black gram and red potato. Compared to the same period last year, most prices showed an upward trend (with the exception of mustard oil).

Prices in regional markets showed a trend similar to that seen in the national average, with an upward trend of the price of coarse rice, wheat flour and broken lentil in all markets with the exception of the major consumer markets of Kathmandu and Pokhara.

Wholesale prices regularly monitored by FNCCI/AEC in the five large markets of Birtamod, Kathmandu, Butwal, Surkhet and Dhangadhi showed an upward trend over the past month for most commodities with the exception of soybean oil. In the Kalimati Fruits and Vegetables Market, the wholesale price of some winter season vegetables showed a sharp decline: prices of cauliflower, cabbage, carrot, tomato, dry onion, radish and spinach decreased by more than 10 On the other hand, the price of off-season vegetables, such as pumpkin, bitter gourd, pointed gourd and christophine, increased by more than 12 percent.

According to the recent macroeconomic situation report by Nepal Rastra Bank, the overall consumer price index (CPI) in January 2014 was 197.6, a decline of 0.4 percent month-onmonth. The inflation rate, as measured by the year-on-year increase in the CPI, was 9.7 percent. The food and beverage group of the CPI was 236.2, a decline of 2.4 percent monthon-month, but an increase of 12.9 percent year-on-year; several sub-groups showed high year-on-year increases: meat and fish (24.5 percent), vegetables (19.0 percent), fruits (14.5 percent), cereal grains (12.7 percent) and spices (10.8 percent). The non-food and services group of the CPI was 169.1, an increase of 1.3 percent month-on-month and 6.9 percent year-on-year.

## Supply


The supply situation across the country is reported as normal with the smooth functioning of markets and transport services. Food stocks in most markets—specifically those with fair weather road access—in the Hill and Mountain regions are reported to be sufficient for a month.


# **Outlook**

Food prices are likely to remain stable in the next month due to improved supplies across the country. However, the price of lean season commodities, mainly vegetables, are expected to increase. The outlook of the winter crop harvest—e.g., wheat and barley—is expected to be good due to recent rainfall across the country.
