HIGHLIGHTS

- In March 2014, retail prices of most food commodities monitored in 12 markets across Nepal showed a marginal increase due to the beginning of the lean season of summer crops and the pre-harvest period of winter crops.
- Overall inflation rate in March 2014 was 8.9 percent. The food and beverage group was relatively higher at 10.8 percent as were several sub-groups: meat and fish (17.1 percent), ghee and oil (13.9 percent), cereal grain (13.9 percent) and legume varieties (12.6 percent).

NATIONAL MARKET DEVELOPMENT

Price

In March 2014, retail prices of most food commodities monitored across the country showed a marginal increase. On a month-on-month basis, retail prices of coarse rice and wheat flour increased by 1.3 and 0.6 percent respectively. Likewise, prices of black gram and broken lentil marginally went up by 1.0 and 0.2 percent respectively, although the price of soybean oil and red potato declined by 0.6 and 0.4 percent respectively. However, the price of chicken meat climbed by 3.4 percent due to an increase in demand. As compared to three months earlier, most prices showed a mixed trend, but compared to the same period last year, most prices showed an upward trend (with the exception of edible oils).

Prices in regional markets showed similar trends as the national average, with an upward trend in the price of coarse rice and wheat flour (with the exception of the Hill and Mountain markets). Likewise, the price of broken lentil showed an upward trend in all markets except in the Terai.

Wholesale prices regularly monitored by FNCCI/AEC in the five large markets of Birtamod, Kathmandu, Butwal, Surkhet and Dhangadhi showed a mixed trend, with an upward trend of the price of coarse rice and a downward trend of prices of black gram and edible oils. In the Kalimati Fruits and Vegetables Market, the wholesale price of most monitored vegetables showed a high seasonal fluctuation: prices of tomato, spinach, pointed gourd, brinjal and cucumber increased by more than 10 percent due to a reduction in supply because of the lean season, while that of bitter gourd, okra, arum and broad leaf mustard went down by more than 7 percent over the past one month.

As per the latest macroeconomic situation report released by Nepal Rastra Bank, the overall consumer price index (CPI) in March 2014 was 196.9, an increase of 0.4 percent month-onmonth. The inflation rate, as measured by the year-on-year increase in the CPI, was 8.9 percent. The food and beverage group of the CPI was 233.6, an increase of 0.6 percent month-on-month, but an increase of 10.8 percent year-onyear; several sub-groups showed higher year-on-year increases: meat and fish (17.1 percent), ghee and oil (13.9 percent), cereal grains (13.9 percent) and legume varieties (12.6 percent). The non-food and services group of the CPI was 169.6, an increase of 0.3 percent month-on-month and 7.1 percent year-on-year.

The supply situation across the country is reported as normal due to increased access to fair weather roads and smooth functioning of markets. NeKSAP district and cluster coordinators report that markets, including those in the Hill and Mountain areas, have sufficient stocks of essential food and non-food items.

Outlook

Most food prices are likely to increase in the next month with the exception of winter crops which are close to being harvested. Moreover, prices of winter vegetables are also expected to rise in the coming months.


The harvest of winter crops, such as wheat and barley, is expected to be better than last year due to timely rainfall and availability of fertilizers. This will improve the availability of these food items in the country.


Average retail price over 12 months period*
