HIGHLIGHTS

- In May 2014, retail prices of most food commodities monitored in 12 markets across Nepal showed a marginal increase due to the onset of the lean season of most crops.
- Overall inflation rate in May 2014 was 9.7 percent. The food and beverage group was higher at 12.9 percent, as were several sub-groups: vegetables (31.6 percent), fruits (15.8 percent), meat and fish (13.7 percent) and cereal grains (10.3 percent).

NATIONAL MARKET DEVELOPMENT

Price

Retail prices of most food commodities monitored across the country in May 2014 showed a marginal increase. On a month-on-month basis, the retail price of coarse rice increased by 0.2 percent, while that of wheat flour went down by 1.3 percent due to an increase in supply of recently harvested crops. Prices of black gram, broken lentil, and soybean oil nominally increased by 0.2, 0.4, and 0.2 percent respectively. Likewise, prices of red potato and chicken meat went up by 4.9 and 1.3 percent respectively. As compared to three months earlier, most prices showed an upward trend with the exception of wheat flour and soybean oil. Compared to the same period last year, most prices showed an upward trend (with the exception of black gram and mustard oil).

Prices in regional markets showed somewhat different trends than the national average, with an upward trend of coarse rice in the hill and mountain markets and a downward trend in the Terai and the major consumer markets (of Kathmandu and Pokhara). Likewise, the price of wheat flour showed a downward trend in the hill and mountain markets and the major consumer markets and an upward trend in the Terai markets

Wholesale prices regularly monitored by FNCCI/AEC in the five large markets of Birtamod, Kathmandu, Butwal, Surkhet and Dhangadhi showed a trend similar to that seen in retail prices. In the Kalimati Fruits and Vegetables Market, the wholesale price of most monitored vegetables showed a high seasonal fluctuation: prices of cauliflower, arum, cabbage, spinach, green peas, and radish increased by more than 15 percent due to a reduction in supply because of the lean season, while that of bitter gourd, pointed gourd, cow pea, okra, and smooth gourd went down by more than 25 percent over the past one month.

The overall consumer price index (CPI) released by Nepal Rastra Bank in May 2014 was 200.4, an increase of 0.8 percent month-on-month. The inflation rate, as measured by the year-on-year increase in the CPI, was 9.7 percent. The food and beverage group of the CPI was 241.9, an increase of 1.6 percent month-on-month, but an increase of 12.9 percent year-on-year; several sub-groups showed higher year-on-year increases: vegetables (31.6 percent), fruits (15.8 percent), meat and fish (13.7 percent), and cereal grains (10.6 percent). The non-food and services group of the CPI was 170.1, an increase of 0.1 percent month-onmonth and 7.0 percent year-on-year.

Supply

The supply situation across the country is reported as normal, although NeKSAP Cluster and District Coordinators report that the supply of food and non-food commodities has started to be disrupted in some hill and mountain markets due to difficulties with transportation (e.g., an increase in river water levels and landslides caused by the monsoon).

Outlook


Most food prices are expected to rise next month with the onset of the lean season. Moreover, the delay in the start of the monsoon, and the potential impact this may have on summer crop production, could also lead to price increases.

Summer crop production is expected to be moderate this year due to the delay, and likely weakening, of the monsoon.



Average retail price over 12 months period*


NPR per kilo or liter
