HIGHLIGHTS

- In February 2016, retail prices of most food commodities monitored in 12 markets across Nepal showed a downward trend due to several factors: normalization of cross-border trade in the Terai, mainly through Birgunj-Raxaul, improved food supplies with increased availability of fuel and transportation and better road access.
- Overall inflation rate in February 2016 was 11.3 percent. The food and beverage group was higher at 12.8 percent, as were several sub-groups: pulses and legumes (39.7 percent), ghee and oil (23.1 percent), meat and fish (12.6 percent) and cereal grains (11.7 percent).

Prices

Retail prices of food commodities monitored across the country decreased in February 2016. On a month-on-month basis, retail prices of coarse rice and wheat flour remained relatively stable, while that of black gram and broken lentil decreased by 2.6 and 5.0 percent respectively. Prices of edible oils decreased by more than 7.0 percent. Likewise the price of red potato decreased sharply by 10.5 percent. However, the price of chicken meat went up by 4.3 percent. Compared to three months earlier, most prices showed an upward trend with the exception of red potato, soybean oil and broken lentil. Compared to the same period last year, most prices showed an upward trend (with the exception of red potato). Overall, the price of most food commodities over the past 12 months showed an upward trend with expected seasonal fluctuations, while that of pulses and edible oils have shown a downward trend since February 2016 (see Figure 1).





Figure 2: Percentage change in retail prices** (1 month & 1 year)

Prices in regional markets (see **Figure 2**) showed somewhat different trends than the national averages, with an upward trend of prices of coarse rice and wheat flour in the major consumer markets of Kathmandu and Pokhara, and a declining trend in the road-accessible mountain and hill markets and the Terai markets (with the exception of prices of wheat flour and broken lentil in the Terai markets, which showed an upward trend). Prices of all commodities showed an upward trend compared to the same period last year.

Wholesale prices regularly monitored by FNCCI/AEC in the five large markets of Birtamod, Kathmandu, Butwal, Surkhet and Dhangadhi showed a downward trend over the past one month. Wholesale prices monitored in the Kalimati Fruits and Vegetables Market mostly showed high seasonal fluctuations month-on-month (see **Table 1**): prices of pointed gourd, pumpkin, brinjal, cauliflower and christophine increased by more than 9 percent due to a reduction in supply, while that of dry onion, green peas, carrot, cabbage and radish decreased by more than 14 percent due to the harvest season.

In February 2016, the overall consumer price index (CPI) released by Nepal Rastra Bank was 109.8, a decrease of 0.6 percent month-on-month. The inflation rate, as measured by the year-on-year increase in the CPI, was 11.3 percent. The food and beverage group of the CPI was 110.0, a decrease of 2.0 percent month-on-month and an increase of 12.8 percent year-on-year; several sub-groups showed higher year-on-year increases: pulses and legumes (39.7 percent), ghee and oil (23.1 percent), meat and fish (12.6 percent) and cereal grains (11.7 percent). The non-food and services group of the CPI was 109.7, an increase of 0.5 percent month-on-month and 10.1 percent year-on-year.

Supply

The food supply situation across the country has improved with an increase in fuel supply and transport services after the resumption of cross-border trade and increased access to fair-weather roads, particularly in the mountains and hills.

Outlook

Most food prices are expected to be stable or decrease due to the resumption of cross-border trade and smooth operation of transport services, even in the mountain and hill markets.

The outlook for the harvest of winter crops, such as wheat and barley, is expected to be lower than last year due to poor rainfall during the growing period. Drought conditions are reported across the mid– and far-western regions.

NPR per kilo or liter
