HIGHLIGHTS

- In June 2014, retail prices of most food commodities monitored in 12 markets across Nepal showed an upward trend due to the lean season of most crops and the onset of the monsoon period.
- Overall inflation rate in June 2014 was 9.5 percent. The food and beverage group was higher at 12.2 percent, as were several sub-groups: vegetables (27.5 percent), meat and fish (16.1 percent), fruits (14.0 percent), and milk and dairy products (11.2 percent).

NATIONAL MARKET DEVELOPMENT

Price

Retail prices of most food commodities monitored across the country in June 2014 showed an upward trend. On a monthon-month basis, the retail price of coarse rice and wheat flour increased by 4.2 percent and 0.7 percent respectively, while that of black gram and broken lentil went up by 2.9 percent and 0.5 percent respectively. Likewise, prices of red potato and soybean oil climbed by 5.0 percent and 1.1 percent respectively. However, the price of chicken meat decreased by 0.9 percent. As compared to three months earlier, most prices showed an upward trend with the exception of wheat flour. Compared to the same period last year, most prices showed an upward trend (with the exception of black gram and mustard oil).

Prices in regional markets mostly showed trends similar to that seen in national averages, with an upward trend of coarse rice. The price of wheat flour remained stable in the hill and mountain markets and the major consumer markets of Kathmandu and Pokhara, while in the Terai markets there was an upward trend in the price.

Wholesale prices regularly monitored by FNCCI/AEC in the five large markets of Birtamod, Kathmandu, Butwal, Surkhet and Dhangadhi showed an upward trend with the exception of soybean oil. In the Kalimati Fruits and Vegetables Market, the wholesale price of most monitored vegetables showed a high seasonal fluctuation: prices of dry onion, cabbage, green peas, radish, and carrot increased by more than 10 percent due to a reduction in supply because of the lean season, while that of bitter gourd, pointed gourd, French bean, okra, and broad mustard leaf went down by more than 13 percent over the past one month.

The overall consumer price index (CPI) released by Nepal Rastra Bank in May 2014 was 201.6, an increase of 0.6 percent month-on-month. The inflation rate, as measured by the year-on-year increase in the CPI, was 9.5 percent. The food and beverage group of the CPI was 244.9, an increase of 1.3 percent month-on-month, but an increase of 12.2 percent year-on-year; several sub-groups showed higher year-onyear increases: vegetables (27.5 percent), meat and fish (16.1 percent), fruits (14.0 percent), and milk and dairy products (11.2 percent). The non-food and services group of the CPI was 170.2, an increase of 0.1 percent month-onmonth and 7.0 percent year-on-year.

Supply

The supply situation across Nepal is reported as normal. However, NeKSAP cluster and district coordinators report that regional highways leading to the hill and mountain areas (including Mahakali, Karnali, Beni-Jomson, Leguwa-Bhojpur, Jayramghat-Diktel) were partially disrupted due to high river water levels and landslides caused by the monsoon; this has resulted in an increase in transportation costs and time.

Outlook


Most food prices are expected to remain high or increase next month due to the lean season and monsoon period. Moreover, prices of seasonal vegetables are likely to decline and off-season vegetables are expected to rise.

Paddy transplantation is late, with roughly half completed due to the delay in the monsoon and below normal rainfall. This indicates a moderate outlook for summer crops.


