#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- National food price inflation remains of significant concern. Nepal Rastra Bank's latest data indicates yearon-year food price inflation over 13 percent and cereal grain price inflation of over 15 percent.
- Expected seasonal price decreases (following the summer crop harvest from October-November) in coarse rice were not experienced in most markets.
- The overall supply situation in the country is good and markets in the hills, mountains and Terai remain generally relatively well stocked.

#### **NATIONAL MARKET DEVELOPMENTS**

#### **Price**

In the markets regularly monitored by MoAC and WFP, the national average price of coarse rice during the monthly monitoring period was Npr 35 kg (the same as last month); the average price of wheat was Npr 36 kg (the same as last month); and the average price of musuro (broken lentil) was Npr 105 kg (compared to Npr 104 kg last month). The average price of potato increased to Npr 35.5 kg (compared to Npr 27 last month).

Food prices have remained relatively stable this month due to continuing good supply following the summer harvest. However, expected seasonal price decreases in the Terai have not been experienced, and the price of coarce rice and wheat flour across the country remains high for this time of

Year on year (y-o-y) food price inflation, as measured by the consumer price index, increased to 13.3 percent in December 2010 on top of 16 percent inflation during the same period last year. The annual price inflation of staple cereal grains in December was 15 percent.

# Supply

The Supply situation in the hills and mountains remained fairly similar this month compared to last. Major roads and trails into mountainous areas of the country remain unblocked and markets are re-stocking food supplies unhindered. In addition, some of the smaller trails badly damaged by monsoon rains (particularly in the Mid and Far West) are now again suitable for food transportation. The summer crop harvest of maize that occurred from August/September in hill and mountain areas is also helping the supply situation.

Every market monitored in the Terai reported that the supply situation had improved this month due to the summer harvest that occurred during October and November. -- Coarse Rice However, despite the overall better supply situation bandhs caused 70 percent of markets monitored in the Terai to close for an average of 2.5 days during the month. The majority of bandhs during the period were related either to petrol price increases or were politically motivated.

#### **Outlook**

In general it is expected that the price of main staple food commodities will gradually increase as Nepal enters a traditional agricultural lean period. The price of wheat and rice may continue to increase until theie next harvests in April/May and October/November respectively.


Suppliers have reported an increase in the wholesale prices of cooking oils (mustard oil and soybean oil), and this has so far mostly resulted in increases in prices in major consumer markets and the terai. It is expected that over the coming months this price increase will transmit to rural markets and wil continue as Indian oil prices have also increased in recent

Transportation costs are also expected to slightly increase due to the recent (and likely ongoing) fuel price increases that are adding to food transportation costs.
