

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- In August 2014, retail prices of most food commodities monitored in 12 markets across Nepal increased due to the ongoing rainy season and lean season period.
- Overall inflation rate in August 2014 was 7.5 percent. The food and beverage group was higher at 10.6 percent, as were several sub-groups: fruits (24.3 percent), vegetables (13.9 percent), meat and fish (11.1 percent), and cereal grains (10.9 percent).

# NATIONAL MARKET DEVELOPMENT

# **Price**

Retail prices of most food commodities monitored across the country showed an upward trend in August 2014. On a month -on-month basis, the retail price of coarse rice and wheat flour increased by 1.2 percent and 1.0 percent respectively, while that of black gram and broken lentil went up by 4.2 percent and 0.5 percent respectively. Likewise, prices of potato and soybean oil climbed up by 9.4 percent and 0.1 percent respectively. However, the price of chicken meat went down by 0.9 percent. As compared to three months earlier, prices showed an upward trend. Similarly, compared to the same period last year, most prices showed an upward trend (with the exception of mustard oil).

Prices in regional markets showed similar trends to national averages, with an upward trend of coarse rice and wheat flour in all markets. However, the price of broken lentil showed a marginal decline in the Terai markets.

Wholesale prices regularly monitored by FNCCI/AEC in the five large markets of Birtamod, Kathmandu, Butwal, Surkhet and Dhangadhi showed a marginal decline over the past one month. In the Kalimati Fruits and Vegetables Market, the wholesale price of most monitored vegetables showed a high seasonal fluctuation: prices of pumpkin, tomato, cow pea and spinach increased by more than 11 percent due to a reduction in supply, while that of cabbage, christophine, brinjal, radish, French bean, smooth gourd and okra went down by more than 14 percent over the past one month.

The overall consumer price index (CPI) released by Nepal Rastra Bank in August 2014 was 207.9, an increase of 1.0 percent month-on-month. The inflation rate, as measured by the year-on-year increase in the CPI, was 7.5 percent. The food and beverage group of the CPI was 257.1, an increase of 2.4 percent month-on-month, but an increase of 10.6 percent year-on-year; several sub-groups showed higher year-onyear increases: fruits (24.3 percent), vegetables (13.9 percent), meat and fish (11.1 percent), and cereal grains (10.9 percent). The non-food and services group of the CPI was 173.0, a decrease of 0.1 percent month-on-month and an increase of 5.0 percent year-on-year.

#### Supply

The supply situation across the country has still not normalized due to the obstruction of roads by landslides and floods. According to NeKSAP cluster and district coordinators, transportation services have yet to resume to some hill and mountain markets with seasonal access to roads.


### **Outlook**

Prices of most food items are likely to increase or remain high in the next month due to the high demand before the festival period.


Recent floods in the mid- and far-western Terai and hills, and excessive rainfall in other areas, have badly affected paddy crops. This indicates a moderate outlook for the paddy crop.
